## JOINT LEARNING

**jolnes** - *Joint Learning in Northern European Studies* is a collaborative project that aims to connect the teaching of Scandinavian And Finnish Studies in Germany, neighbouring countries and Scandinavia. Within the cooperation network, digital teaching is created and offered to all master students of the participating departments. A further opening to advanced bachelor students is planned.

The digital teaching offered by **jolnes** complements local face-to-face teaching. One to a maximum of two courses are offered per semester. These can be online seminars (webinars) and digital or digitized lectures. All courses are supervised and moderated.

## FLEXIBLE – INTERNATIONAL – DIGITAL

More individual study options through distance teaching and joint learning.

- Spatial and temporal flexibility: easier coordination of job, family and studies
- Flexibility in content: Getting to know the research of other Scandinavian and Finnish departments
- Networking: studying together with students from other German and European departments
- Training of job-related skills: Use of web conferencing tools, digital project work and cooperation
- for departments: resource-saving expansion of the range of courses and enhancement of expertise in digital higher education

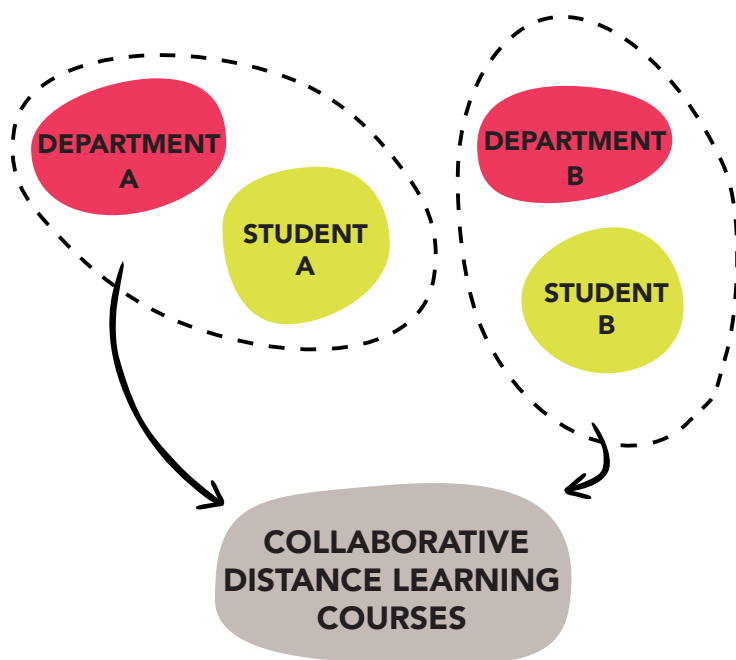
## REGISTRATION
