

TRANSNATIONAL ASPECTS OF FINNISH LITERATURE (Viola Parente-Čapková, University of Turku)

The course will address the issue on transnational, transcultural, multilingual and transborder aspects of Finnish literature through various case studies, analyzing the category of the "national" and its place in the history of Finnish literature.

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The objective of the course is to make students acquainted with various aspects of Finland's literature and culture in past and present, as well as to develop, in this particular context, a deeper analytical and methodological understanding of the category of "national" literature and its role in the processes of formation of the discipline of literary history. Course dates: April 12th - May 21st
